C. Kirk Johnson, Ph.D.

Dr. Johnson has been a licensed psychologist in the state of Washington since 1982. He is also state certified as a sex offender evaluation and treatment specialist. He received his bachelor and masters degree from the University of Oregon. His doctorate degree was obtained from the University of Arizona in 1981.

While at the University of Arizona, Dr. Johnson completed an internship in a county psychiatric hospital. He has also completed an externship in the Department of Family Medicine at the University of Arizona Medical School.

Dr. Johnson has worked previously as a juvenile probation officer. Before entering private practice he was the director of child and family programs at a community mental health center. He has also served as director of out patient and emergency services at a community mental health center.

Dr. Johnson's training has been primarily within the theoretical framework of Adlerian psychology. Specific treatment techniques will be designed to meet the individual needs of a given client or family. Any treatment plan will be discussed with the client.

Entering into a treatment or evaluation process with a psychologist is a typically out of the ordinary experience for most individuals. If you are uncomfortable with any aspect of the treatment or evaluation process you should make this clear. It is important to remember that *you are the consumer and you should trust your reactions.*

The usefulness of treatment may be quite dependent on the level of comfort you feel with the provider. If you are uncomfortable with the style of Dr. Johnson let him know this. Such a reaction is not unusual and no feelings will be hurt. Dr. Johnson may then refer you to another provider who might be better able to meet your particular needs.

Since you are seeing a licensed psychologist you have protections defined through state regulation. The licensing process requires an individual to meet stringent standards of training, pass state written and oral examinations and receive ongoing continuing education training. You are also protected if you believe that you have been dealt with unethically, incompetently or illegally. Psychologists are regulated through a state board of professional examiners and you may report any concern you have to that board. The address of the board is:
